- 3. Pull-out learning

After-school/after-class support:

- 1. Chinese learning groups (Levels: P.1, 3, 6)
- 2. Peer cooperative learning (Levels: P.1, 2, 3, 6)
- (2) Our school's measures for creating an inclusive learning environment included#:
 - 1. Organising activities which promote cultural integration/raise sensitivity to diverse cultures and religions:

- 2. Providing opportunities for NCS students to learn and interact with their Chinese-speaking peers in school or outside school:
 - In terms of extra-curricular activities, NCS students are invited to participate in our school teams like basketball, fencing, Wushu, Chinese painting to offer extra

communication and cooperation opportunities to them with local students. Having the increased chances to interact with Chinese-speaking peers, they can better blend in our school life through team building activities.

Discussing the learning progress (including learning of Chinese) of NCS student(s) with their parents on a regular basis, as well as explaining and emphasising the importance for their children to master the Chinese language as appropriate.
